TERMS OF REFERENCE

Background:

Building-Integrated Photovoltaics (BIPV) is recognised as potential innovative approaches for generating clean energy and support in India's sustainable energy future. The German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) is funding a dedicated project under its Development Partnership with the Private Sector program (develoPPP). The Development Partnership with the Private Sector (develoPPP) project aims to establish scientific evidence, raise awareness, and build capacities of key stakeholders in the solar energy ecosystem and related fields. Hence, it plans to collaborate with diverse partners, many of whom have already demonstrated their commitment to the project.

Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) is leading the implementation of this develoPPP project and a crucial aspect of the project involves developing comprehensive BIPV guidelines and fostering strong research & development (R&D) and industry collaborations with established European partners.

Context:

India has committed to significantly boosting its renewable energy capacity to 500 GW by 2030 at COP26. With electricity demand projected to grow by nearly 5% annually until 2040 and an urgent need for climate change mitigation, scaling up innovative solar photovoltaic (PV) applications across the country is crucial. The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has identified building-integrated photovoltaics (BIPV) and rail/road-integrated photovoltaics (RIPV) as key new and innovative solar applications for proliferation.

The project aims to achieve this by:

1. Setting up of demonstration projects of Building integrated PV technology in India across feasible sites.
2. Generating accessible scientific knowledge on the technical performance, economic viability, and environmental benefits of BIPV and RIPV in the Indian context.
3. Implementing comprehensive skill development programs to build a skilled workforce for these technologies.
4. Introducing supportive policy reforms and a regulatory framework through evidence-based advocacy.

Purpose of the Tender

GIZ India would like to procure Building Integrated PV modules for establishing pilot projects in India. In the current scenario, the BIPV ecosystem in India is not fully mature and developed. It is aimed that through the pilots which are planned on government owned infrastructure, it will help accelerate the exposure of this technology. The bidder is expected to provide BIPV modules of certain specifications which shall be ultimately put up as per a formulated design.

BIPV panels parameters

The parameters based on which the BIPV modules are different from the standard modules available are:

1. Variability in sizes and shapes.
2. Element of colour on the front part of the panels, to cater for architectural purposes.
3. Glass thickness on the front and back of modules.
4. Capacity of modules.

Detailed technical requirements and specifications are mentioned in Table2.

Detailed Scope of Work

The scope of work includes “**Supply of Building Integrated PV panels in India**” as illustrated in Specifications.

- **Building Integrated PV modules:** A set of customized Building integrated PV modules of around **40 kWp** in terms of total capacity of the whole plant must be supplied.

The Contractor will carry out and complete the said work under this contract in every respect in conformity with the contract documents and with the direction of and to the satisfaction of the owner's (GIZ is referred to as Owner) and on-site representatives. The contractor will furnish all required labour, packing material and means of transport as listed under Price submission (Annex D), which are necessary and customary to be performed under this contract.

Supply details:

- The selected bidder shall make available the required equipment as specified in table 1 of the 'bill of materials and quantities' section and as per the specifications listed in table 2 of the 'technical specifications' section.
- **Please note that the detailed project report of the BIPV project shall be shared to the winning bidder, based on which the bidder shall proceed as per the work plan mentioned in Annex E.**

The selected bidder will be responsible for the following:

- The responsibility of transportation / loading / unloading / handing over to GIZ. The bidder is expected to supply the panels at the site
- The site is in **Trivandrum, Kerala**. Detailed address shall be provided after the bidding process is completed.
- Shipping of equipment shall be in coordination with the designated GIZ member.
- At the shipment site, the selected bidder shall unpack the shipment in presence of GIZ officials and take formal acceptance of material once quality is approved. The shipment must arrive in suitable form of packaging (wooden boxes OR A racks), which is safe for

transportation within India. It is upon the bidder to take measures to ensure safe transportation.

- All documentation and formalities regarding transport (Shipment documentation, port rents, etc) shall be taken care by the bidder and must be highlighted in the proposal.
- Pre- Installation technical support: Under this mandate, the supplier shall be required to provide technical support required during installation, if any to GIZ.

Made-in-India modules will be given preference

- Once the equipment is dispatched, the supplier shall share all details of consignment including its mode of transport, vehicle details and anticipated arrival schedule of consignment.
- After arrival of consignment, supplier shall inform GIZ staff, who shall arrange for unloading place access for consignment loaded vehicle. Supplier shall also share name, details, and IDs of main point of contact of this team with GIZ staff.
- Supplier shall share details of its unloading, team details and schedule of related activities.
- Pre and post installation support: The contractor must address and promptly respond to pre and post installation troubleshooting services as needed, since the installation will be carried out by the project team and will require technical assistance based on the product design.
- All bidders are expected to submit technical specifications sheet and G.A drawing along with their bids which will be one of the assessment criteria.

The contract agreement **supply of Building Integrated PV panels in India** will be executed between the awardee agency/ firm and GIZ. The terms & conditions incorporated therein shall be binding on the agency and valid for a period of 1 year.

Liquidated Damages and Termination of Contract

Except because of force majeure, if the bidder fails to perform the scope of work, to the satisfaction of GIZ, within the time period specified in the delivery schedule or within the extended time period if any, GIZ shall without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price as liquidated damage, a sum equivalent to 1% of the price of the unperformed work/ services for each week of delay until actual completion of work, up to a maximum deduction of 10%. Once the maximum is reached GIZ may consider termination of the contract.

Force Majeure

Force Majeure Events shall include the following events to the extent they satisfy the foregoing requirements:

- Natural disasters, including but not limited to lightning, earthquake, volcanic eruption, landslide, flood, cyclone, typhoon, tornado
- any act of war (whether declared or undeclared), invasion, armed conflict or act of foreign enemy, blockade, embargo, revolution, riot, insurrection, terrorist or military action

- any requirement, action or omission to act pursuant to any judgment or order of any court or judicial authority or Statutory Entity in India of any Law or any of their respective obligations under this Agreement
- expropriation and/or compulsory acquisition of the Project in whole or in part by any Government or Statutory Entity
- radioactive contamination or ionising radiation originating from a source in India or resulting from another Force Majeure Event excluding circumstances where the source or cause of contamination or radiation is brought or has been brought into or near the Project Site by the Affected Party or those employed or engaged by the Affected Party
- industry wide strikes and labour disturbances having a nationwide impact in India.

Force Majeure Event shall not include the following conditions, except to the extent that they are consequences of a Force Majeure Event:

- unavailability, late delivery or change in cost of steel, equipment, materials, spares parts or consumables in local market
- delay in performance of any contractor or sub-contractor or their agents
- non-performance resulting from normal wear and tear of plant, materials or equipment at the bidder's facility
- strike or labour disturbances at the facilities of the bidder
- insufficiency of finances or funds or the agreement becoming onerous to perform
- non-performance caused by, or concerned with, the bidder negligent and
- intentional acts, errors or omissions
- failure to comply with Law, or
- breach of, or default under this Agreement

Delivery of Material

The Bidder should note that it must furnish and agree with GIZ on the terms of the delivery of the material at the project site.

The equipment delivery must be coordinated with GIZ before the dispatch to the project site.

A. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Scope: The scope of work to be carried out under this contract is- The Contractor will carry out and complete the said work under this contract in every respect in conformity with the contract documents and with the direction of and to the satisfaction of the Owner's (GIZ is referred to as Owner) site representative. The contractor will furnish all labour, materials, and equipment (except those to be supplied by the owner) as listed under BOQ and specified otherwise, transportation and incidental necessary for supply, and commissioning of the complete system as described in the technical specifications and as listed in BOQ. This also includes any material, equipment, appliances, and incidental work not specifically mentioned herein or noted on the drawings/documents as being furnished or installed, but which are necessary and customary to be performed under this contract:

- Submission of samples, technical specifications, and G.A drawings of panel.
- Manufacturing of the panels

- Supply of the manufacturing panels at the site.

- 2. Performance Guarantee:** The contractor will perform the work in accordance with the tender, technical drawings and specifications forming part of the contract. At the close of the work and before issue of final certificate of virtual completion, the contractor will furnish written performance guarantee against defective materials and workmanship for a period of **one year** from date of delivery. The Contractor will hold himself fully responsible replacement, free of cost to Owner because of defective workmanship.
- 3. Materials & Equipment:** All materials and equipment will conform to the relevant Indian Standards and will be of the approved make and design. Contractor will be responsible for the safe custody of all materials and will insure them against theft or damage in handling or storage etc.
- 4. Completion Certificate:** On completion, a certificate will be furnished by the Contractor countersigned by the supervisor, under whose direct supervision the handover of solar modules was carried out.

- The bids will be complete in all respect, and the bidder will submit all the relevant documents as described under this tender. If required, GIZ may solicit in writing further information from the bidder.
The bidders must quote for all the items. In case of partial quoting of items, the bid shall be rejected.
- Bidders are requested to send the Technical and Commercial proposal in **separate attachments** (Technical & Financial) in pdf format, in a single mail/multiple emails along with all supporting documents in a compressed folder not exceeding file size of **20 MB** in total. Files/Folder more than 20 MB of size will not be delivered in the above-mentioned email ID's resulting in non-submission of the bids.
- The bidders can submit the proposal(s)/zip folders either in one email or two emails, based on the file size/bandwidth of folders.
- Uploading of bids is prohibited on open sources like **google drive, drop box etc.** bidders submitting their bids on these platforms shall be immediately **disqualified**.
- Any claims of non-receipt of bids/pre-bid queries shall not be considered later in case the bidder fails to produce the delivery receipt of their bids/pre-bid queries sent to the quotation id.
- In case the bid is not delivered in the qn_quotation@giz.de email, due to any technical glitch or for any other reasons, it would be entirely GIZ's discretion, whether to seek the bid again from the bidder or not, therefore it is imminent to keep read receipt or delivery receipt of all submission for reference.

Price Submission

The price quoted should be exclusive of taxes (GST) and tax rate should be clearly indicated.

(a) If there is no mention of taxes in the price bid, it will be presumed that your rate is inclusive of taxes.

(b) The financial proposal must be duly signed and stamped by the authorised signatory with a covering letter, mentioning complete details of the company.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria for participation in tender process

- Any arithmetical error by the Bidder in Price Bid or in the additions or in carrying forward subtotals to the summary or to the Tender will be corrected during the evaluation of the Tenders. In such cases the Tender sum will be adjusted accordingly, and the Bidder will be informed. It will be assumed that the unit price rates entered in the Price Bid are correct.
